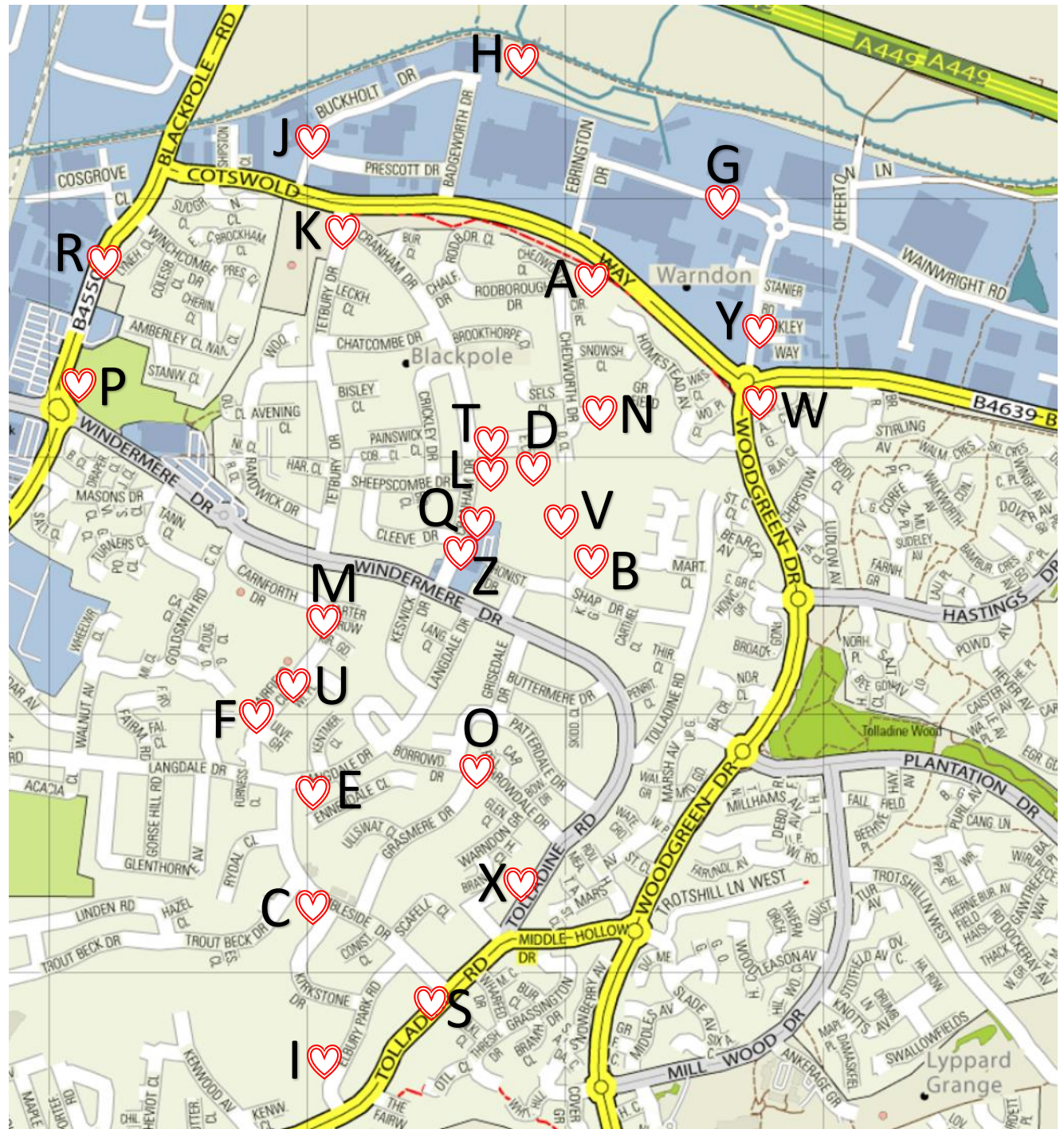


THANKS TRACK

- C. Shopping Spree: Stand by lamppost 12025 and give thanks for these shops. Especially give thanks for the newsagents, and all those journalists and broadcasters who have helped us keep up-to-date with all we need to know this year.
- D. Palm Trees in the Desert: Are you at the gates to Oasis? Good, you are in the right place to give thanks for all the staff and children who make this such a special place!
- E. All On Board: This bus stop with lamppost 4399 reminds us of all the drivers who have kept people on the move this year. Give thanks for bus drivers, train staff and taxis.
- F. Doctor Who?: Lamppost 8042 puts you outside our GPs and one of our pharmacists. Give thanks for all the work that has gone into to looking after everyone this year.
- G. Postman Pat's House: Find lamppost 7803. You will see all the sorting office activity going on. Give thanks for all the ways that we've stayed in touch with each other this year.



- H. Canal Steps: Between locks 9 and 10 on the canal, find this place to pause and give thanks for the canal and the open space it has given people and wildlife during this last year.
- I. Dogs Welcome: DP 1668 marks one of the entrances to Gorse Hill and Elbury Mount and Severn Trent reservoir. Give thanks for all the people working in water, gas and electricity companies who has looked after us this year.
- J. Workplaces: We are in the middle of the factories and warehouses. Look for lamppost 4897. Give thanks for all the jobs, remembering as well those who still need a job.
- K. Red Cranes: If you can find lamppost 4197, then you are in the right place to give thanks for everything this primary school gives to the local community.
- L. X Marks the Spot: In 2023, St Wulstan's will be celebrating 60 years on this site! Give thanks for all the baptisms, funerals, weddings, lunch clubs, Scouts groups and so much more that has happened on this very spot.
- M. Busy Busy Busy: There are lots of classrooms in the schools on this site. Give thanks for all that is done here to support families.
- N. The Carpenter's Corner: Lamppost 4301 puts you are outside the church and school. Both places are important for families in our neighbourhood. Give thanks for the staff and volunteers who keep both these places going.
- O. Home Sweet Home: Lamppost 4434 sits quietly in the midst of our estate. There's nothing 'special' here --- just the extraordinary families and neighbours that make up our community. Give thanks for the people of Warndon, and count rainbows as you go!
- P. Trolley Park: We are right in the heart of the retail parks here. Give thanks for the food shops that have stayed open, and for the other shops and food outlets working so hard to open safely.
- Q. On Parade N: At this end of the parade you can give thanks for everyone who helps keep us safe and secure in our own homes. Can you see the housing association and the police office? Who else has kept you safe this year? Give thanks for them too!
- R. Motoring Along: Keyworkers and deliveries have all needed fuel this year. Give thanks for petrol stations like this one and the staff who have kept them open.
- S. Rainbows & Paws: Look for the house with the rainbow and teddy bears waving hello! It's the bears' neighbours we need. We are here to give thanks for everyone who has helped look after our animals this year.
