## TODAY'S PRAYER & READINGS

**Faithful Creator, whose  
mercy never fails: deepen  
our faithfulness to you and  
to your living Word, Jesus  
Christ our Lord.**

from Exodus 33 & 34

Moses said, 'Show me your glory, I pray.'

And God said, 'I will make all my goodness pass before you, and will proclaim before you the name, "The Lord"; and I will be gracious to whom I will be gracious, and will show mercy on whom I will show mercy. But', he said, 'you cannot see my face; for no one shall see me and live.'

And the Lord continued, 'See, there is a place by me where you shall stand on the rock; and while my glory passes by I will put you in a cleft of the rock, and I will cover you with my hand until I have passed by; then I will take away my hand, and you shall see my back; but my face shall not be seen.'

The Lord said to Moses, 'Be ready in the morning, and come up in the morning to Mount Sinai and present yourself there to me, on the top of the mountain.'
