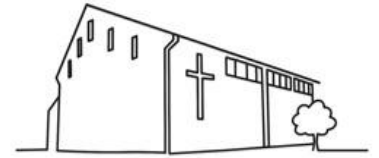

Throughout the centuries, Easter has never been a single day but a fifty-day sabbath, stretching from sunrise on Easter morning to the Spirit falling upon the disciples at nine o'clock on Pentecost morning. This year we do this with a new ABIDE season called *The Easter Threshold*. Our Sunday worship will listen in on the first of the New Testament epistles bearing St Peter's name. Each Sunday the passage from 1 Peter will sit at the centre of the service, alongside the Gospel and the reading from Acts, helping us listen for what the resurrection means for the life of the church. The letter speaks with remarkable clarity about hope, courage, humility, suffering and community — themes that continue to shape Christian life today.

As ever, the idea behind this ABIDE season is that exploration happens at our own pace in our own way. Some people will encounter the season mainly through Sunday worship, others through using the ABIDE resources at home, and others again through the Wednesday or Friday groups meeting at the Vicarage. Together they form a shared attempt to give the Easter season the attention it deserves — learning, week by week, what it means to live on the far side of the resurrection.
